



Outside of work I enjoy playing sport (soccer) and I also have a background in music and performing arts. I might get the guitar out in one of my shifts but we'll see how we go haha!




MEET OUR STAFF




CONNOR - EDUCATOR




JEMMA - EDUCATOR

MADDY - EDUCATOR (VAC CARE)



TERM FOCUS

Our focus this term...

The end of Term 1 and the start of term 2 has seen a National Shortage of staff, resulting in OSHC services around the nation having to cap numbers to meet the required ratio for their sessions.

We have certainly felt the pinch here at our service, especially on a Wednesday and Thursday afternoon. We have made many attempts to advertise for new and capable staff, however most advertisements have gone unanswered due to the statewide shortage.

New changes have rolled in, changing the qualifications needed to become a With kindness, 'qualified' educator. Qualified educators are imperative to services, as we must legally consider how many qualified's are needed compared to how many children are attending.

Luckily we have an educator, who has been here for over a year now, that is now recognised as a 'qualified educator' after the new changes have been made. This provides us with a small amount of wriggle room, however we are still struggling with staffing due to the educator shortage.

We have successfully hired some unqualified staff to fill some gaps. Our focus this term is to hire, train and guide any and all new staff so that we can be proud of a strong team of educators, who have wonderful relationships with children and families.

In our staff meetings, we will have a strong focus on how this will look, and outline the necessary steps that we will need to take while we embark on this journey.

As always, we appreciate your constructive feedback, and are eager for your to meet our new staff.

MY TIME, OUR PLACE OUTCOMES

OUTCOME 1: CHILDREN HAVE A STRONG SENSE OF IDENTITY

- 1.1 Children feel safe, secure and supported.
- 1.2 Children develop their autonomy, inter-dependence, resilience and sense of agency.

OUTCOME 2: CHILDREN ARE CONNECTED WITH AND CONTRIBUTE TO THEIR WORLD

- 2.1 Children develop a sense of belonging to groups and communities and an understanding of the reciprocal rights and responsibilities necessary for active community participation.
- 2.2 Children respond to diversity with respect.
- 2.3 Children become aware of fairness.
- 2.4 Children become socially responsible and show respect for the environment.

OUTCOME 3: CHILDREN HAVE A STRONG SENSE OF WELLBEING

- 3.1 Children become strong in their social and emotional wellbeing.
- 3.2 Children take increasing responsibility for their own health and physical wellbeing.

OUTCOME 4: CHILDREN ARE CONFIDENT AND INVOLVED LEARNERS

- 4.1 Children develop dispositions such as curiosity, cooperation, confidence, creativity, commitment, enthusiasm, persistence, imagination and reflexivity.
- 4.2 Children use a range of skills and processes such as problem solving, inquiry, experimentation, hypothesising, researching and investigating.
- 4.3 Children transfer and adapt what they have learned from one context to another.
- 4.4 Children resource their own learning through connecting with people, place, technologies and natural and processed materials.

OUTCOME 5: CHILDREN ARE EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATORS

- 5.1 Children interact verbally and non-verbally with others for a range of purposes.
- 5.2 Children engage with a range of texts and gain meaning from these texts.
- 5.3 Children collaborate with others, express ideas and make meaning using a range of media and communication technologies.


Woodhouse Activity Centre and Funtopia were two highlights of the holidays, and the events that unfolded were spoken about time and time again.


